If under the age of 14 Licence must state part can only be taken by child of about same age.	6 consecutive or 5 in any 7 day period	Not to exceed 3½ hours	Not to exceed 2½ hours	Not before 10 am Up to 13 10 pm 14+ 10.30 pm  or 30 mins after end of child's own performance  or 11 pm on not more than 3 evenings per week but no more than 8 evenings in 4 consecutive weeks.

There must be 14 hours between end of one performance and beginning of next performance/rehearsal.

Child may only take part in one performance each day unless he takes the same part.

If required to attend school after the morning rehearsal/performance he/she must not take part in another rehearsal/performance that day.

An interval of at least 1½ hours between rehearsals/performances except on 2 days in any week when interval or not less than 45 minutes allowed. Child not to be at place of performance for more than 6 hours.
